O.W.A.T PROJECTS

The Artesian @ Oasis

It is an OWAT project where powerful worship ignites hope by hosting the life-changing presence of God through songs and spoken word. The Artesian represents OWAT's collective journey to go deeper in pursuing the heart of God and inspiring a passion for worship among those reached/touched, sharing the tangible love of Jesus one life at a time.

Project Summary

OWAT members **develop prayers** around different topics (up to approx. **3 minutes in length**).

OWAT instrumentalists **write music** to accompany each prayer.

Working together, the prayer and music speak life, freedom, faith, hope and love into the lives of all who experience them.

Happy Birthday Blessings Video

This is a project where Pastor Tyon and OWAT ignite hope by extending their love to the Oasis congregation through a **Birthday Blessing Video** to the **congregants** on their birthdays.

Project Summary

Pastor Tyon and OWAT create/record a Birthday Blessing/Song video for Oasis birthday celebrants.

The Birthday Blessing Video is delivered via email to the Oasis congregants who are in the Oasis database.

The Journey @ Oasis

This is an Oasis Church project where powerful worship ignites hope by hosting life-changing presence of God through themed starter devotions and prayer prompts.

Project Summary

- The journey occurs over a **minimum of 12 days** and creates a framework for developing a close relationship with God
- **OWAT and the intercessory Team** collaborates to create a collection of short **(5-minute) guided devotions**, with a prayer prompt and questions that inspire additional thoughts

The OWAT Sign-Up Table

The purpose of the OWAT Sign-Up Table is to create awareness among our OASIS Church attenders about OWAT and to draw interest among those who have gifts and talents in worship and arts.

The OWAT Sign-Up Table is set up monthly in the lobby after each service with OWAT-related props and flyers. OWAT Team Members will be manning the table to answer questions on the spot about the ministry.

Creative Worship Night “aka” Overflow

During Creative Worship Night a.k.a. “Overflow”, **various elements of worship** are incorporated into the worship experience. There will be dance, painting, prayer, and different styles of worship that engage the worshippers’ senses, minds, hearts and actions.

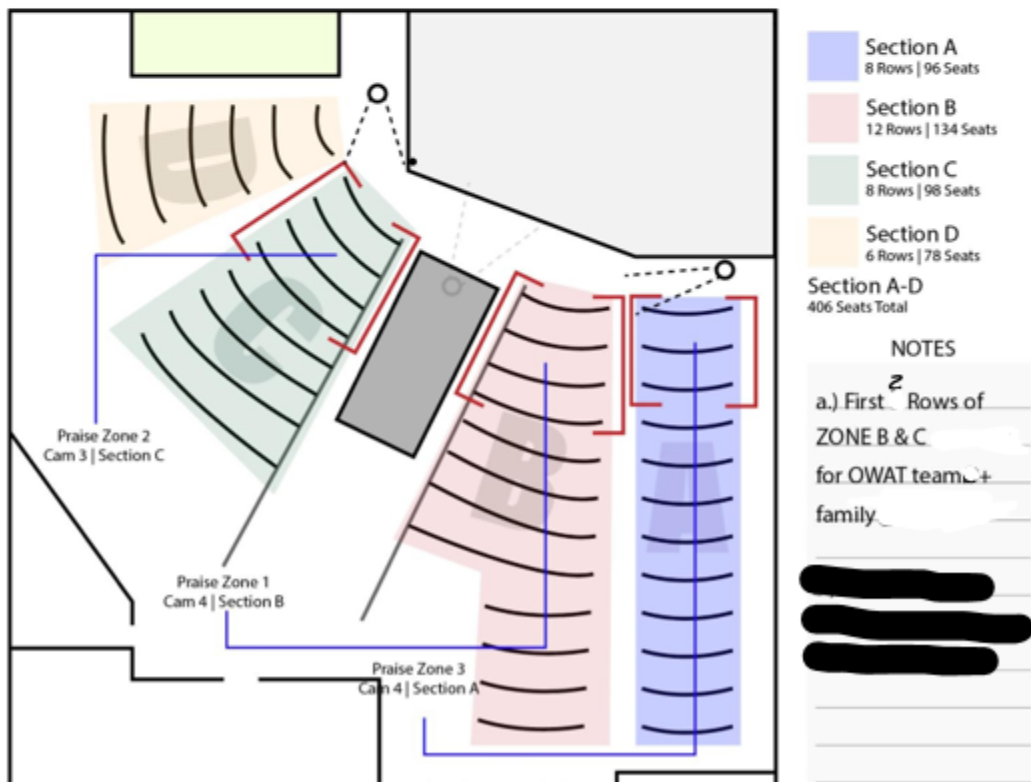

- a) 7 soprano section (by the drums)
- b) 7 tenor section (center)
- c) 7 alto section (other side of me)



Audio



1. **House Goal:** to achieve a more Dynamic Concert Sound that takes over the room!
2. **Stage Goal:** to give teams presenting what they need in order to minister effectively through music.
3. **Hand Signals:** [remember to confirm hand signals back to the stage] After they get your attention, they will often point to the subject they're wanting to adjust (ie wedge, tracks, a mic, or an instrument)

- a) 🙋, I need your attention
- b) 👍, Give me more plz
- c) 🙇, Give me less plz
- d) 🙌 I am okay now. Thanks!

Note: Periodically, I evaluate all our systems / process, so if you come up with something different for me to consider (I'm open); however, wait until that time / and connect with me directly before any changes are made.

Screens



1. Energy

- a) I'm looking for motion Backgrounds to complement each song's tempo. This is how you partner with me to help produce more energy in the room.

2. Screen- Praise

- a) Work to build a library of scriptures that prompts people to praise and/or to worship
 - i. There are instrumental sections in songs where we do what I call "open worship," it's when we pause from singing song lyrics and simply fill the atmosphere with praise & adoration to the Lord; .when you hear me say things like ...
 - a) "make melody unto the Lord"
 - b) "sing out your own song"
 - c) "Lift up a shout of praise"
 - d) Etc

3. Details Matter

- a) Work to make sure we're good
 - i. Grammar
 - ii. Spelling
 - iii. Spacing
 - iv. Double-check the scriptures and points with the same standards.
 - v. Check that all of the footnote reference letters are removed from the scriptures so that it reads correctly

4. Song Map

- a) Sunday Morning Services - are programmed (set from rehearsals)
- b) Worship Night - we try to stick with the sequence of the song however sections may be looped and/improvised. Be ready for that.

5. Know the Songs

- a) Be very Familiar with the songs
 - i. Stay ahead - Spend time with our music we do

- a) Using WWIB song video spacing (ref)
- b) Song Leader(s) on / splitting the X



2. Stage Presence

- a) Help the Stage (band / singers etc) w/ achieving good and engaging stage presence.
 - i. Remember the takeaways discussed from our last watch party (WWIB). I'd like us to continue to work towards achieving that and more over the next several weeks.

3. Goal:

- a) Remember that I'm wanting to use our monthly Worship Nights to position us to produce live worship videos with that type of content, movement, shots, energy. (Refer to WWIB song video)
- b) I'm counting on you to use tonight (Wednesdays) to creatively strategize, working with what we have to achieve what I'm wanting!

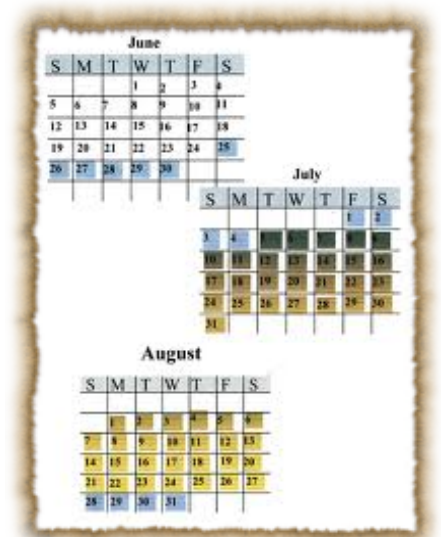

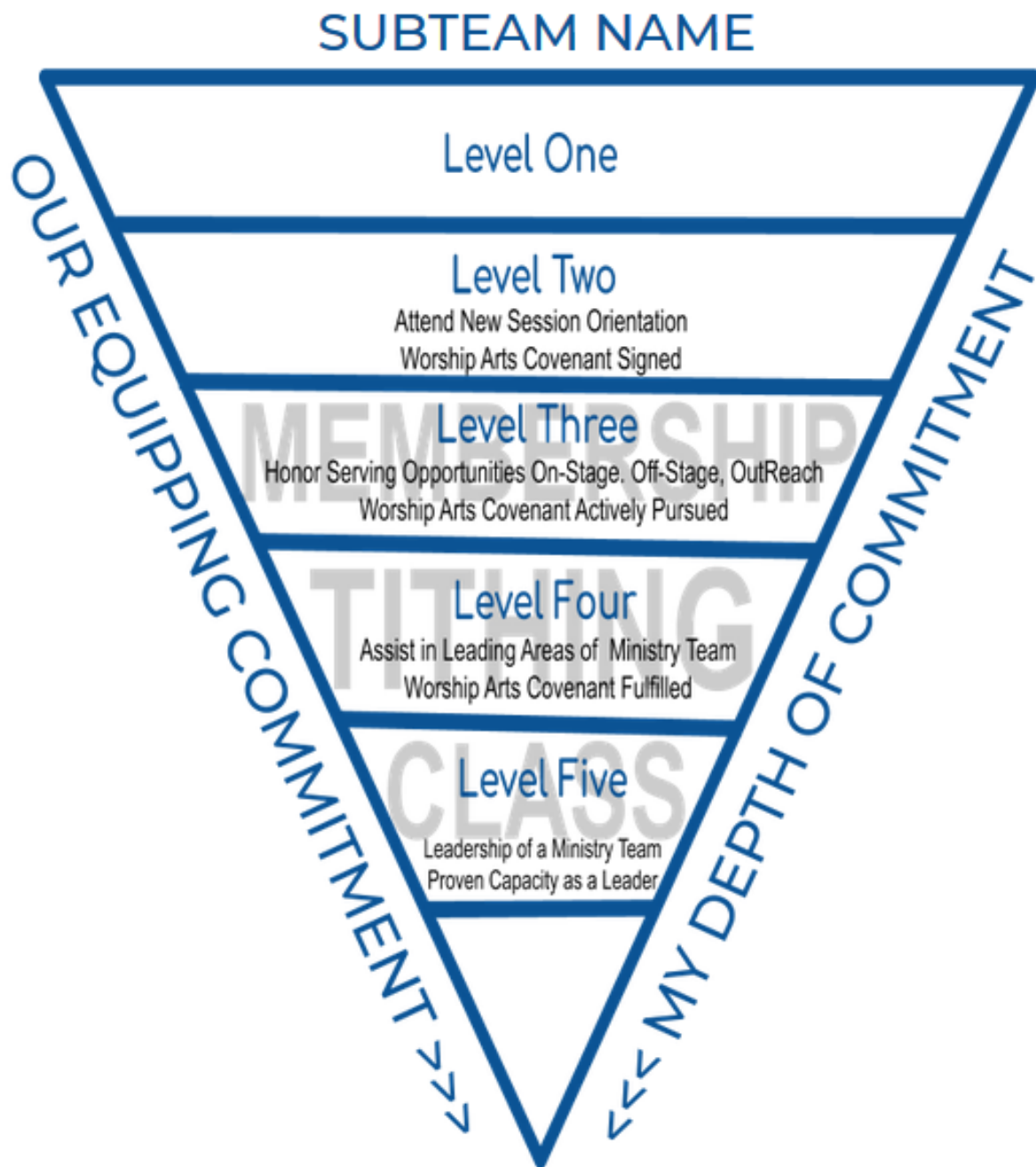
